



There has been much debate over recent years about the best way to teach reading, but the strongest body of evidence supports a structured phonics program, with the emphasis on the development of the students' awareness of sounds in words, or 'phonological awareness'.

We now know that a certain level of Phonological Awareness is essential for the acquisition of literacy and that a child's level of skill in this area is a reliable predictor of later reading ability. Early language experiences play an important role in the development of early sound awareness and improving a child's Phonological Awareness has been shown to enhance their literacy outcomes.

Cued Articulation is a system devised by a Speech Pathologist which fosters an understanding of the sound structure of the language. In Prep to Year 2 it facilitates the development of Phonological Awareness. Cued Articulation is easy and fun to learn, when taught alongside an understanding of the patterns involved in normal speech development.
